Acer's (Maples) Acers (Maples) are all easily grown in well-drained soils with reasonable moisture in Spring & Summer. They are valued for their foliage, which may be variegated or have outstanding Autumn colour & also have attractive bark. Grow large maples as specimen trees, or smaller varieties for patios or smaller gardens. Maples are also highly valued for growing in containers.

Acer Aratama (Topiary) - This rare and desirable dwarf is slow growing with elegant thin branches. The five-lobed leaves begin as brick red in spring, turn purple, red and green in summer then finally turn gold & orange late autumn. (1.5mx1m)		\$59.95
Acer Bloodgood – One of our most popular maples! Distinctive small upright tree. Deep maroon-red foliage carried well throughout the season into late summer & turns vibrant red in Autumn. Showy red seeds. (4mx2m)		\$65.00
Acer Chishio - A slow growing small Maple suitable for town gardens or a special container. Flame pink leaves burst forth in spring gradually turning a more subdued green. The vivid pink red tones return in autumn. Very attractive and desirable. Protect from strong winds. (1.3mx1m)		\$55.00
Acer Crimson Queen —A spreading weeping form with scarlet-red stems & finely dissected deep reddish-purple leaves. Retains leaf colour throughout Summer. Scarlet red in Autumn. (1mx1.5m)		\$78.00
Acer Earthfire - This is a small but gorgeous lace leaf that has an interesting green-red combination happening on its new growth. The very dissected leaves display various shades of red throughout summer and autumn. Prefers filtered light in a sheltered position. (1.3mx1m)		\$55.00
Acer Emerald Lace - This Japanese Maple is one of the fastest growing dissectum. A wonderful garden specimen, the spring growth is lime green sometimes with orange margins when placed in more sun. Very heat tolerant, Emerald Lace even tolerates full sun better than most green maples, but preferring some shade in hot climates. Fall colour is red which is quite rare for green dissectum, which usually display yellow to orange autumn colour. (4mx3m)		\$78.00
Acer Fireglow - Fireglow is a popular type of Japanese maple, it forms a small, neat, upright tree, the dark purple leaves hold their colour throughout the summer & as the weather turns, the leaves get darker before they fall off in winter. It is an ideal specimen tree or focal point in a smaller garden. The delicate looking, finely cut foliage is actually quite tough if protected from strong wind. (3mx2.5m)	1.2m	\$65.00
Acer Fjeilheim - A dwarf Sango kaku. Soft, lime-green, red-margined foliage in spring. Mid-summer green leaves, and bright-gold leaves in autumn. Outstanding brilliant red bark in winter and spring. Prefers moist, well-drained soils. (1.8mx1.2m)

Acer Freemanii – Summer leaves are a rich medium green, autumn colour is bright orange. Reddish flowers. Tolerates most soils & can handle dry conditions once established. Oval in shape with ascending branches. (10m)		\$49.95
Acer Freemanii “Jeffers Red” - A hardy selected quick growing upright form with a dense crown. Being this variety a silver maple cross, it makes it more wind tolerant than other maples. It has excellent gold, orange and bright scarlet autumn colours, ideal for an avenue. Hardy & deciduous.	2m	\$55.00
Acer Green Mist - A vigorous, cascading lace-leaf Japanese maple with soft green, deeply-cut leaves that provide a soft "misty" appearance. Autumn colour is absolutely outstanding with blends of bright orange & red. (2.5mx1m)		\$78.00

Acer Hog yuku - This really is a lovely maple with fresh glossy green spring and summer foliage that turns vibrant shades of yellow and orange in the autumn. Strong upright growth habit. (5mx4.5m)		\$65.00
Acer Japanese Sunrise - Attractive branches which are red on one side and yellow on the other. Upright wide, flat topped growth habit. Leaves emerge yellow-green, fresh green for the Summer and turn yellow, gold & crimson in autumn. (4mx3m)		\$59.95
Acer Lace Lady - Feathery foliage that emerges burgundy red in the spring and is known for holding its red colour right through the summer taking on a vibrant crimson red in autumn. (1.5mx1m)		\$78.00
Acer Mikawa Yatsubusa - A naturally dwarf growing variety, multi-stemmed with dense, overlapping foliage. In spring, the new leaves are yellow-green in colour then darkening as they mature and in autumn they turn to bright shades of orange and scarlet. May be grown as a feature/specimen, in containers & is also used to create bonsai. (1.5mx1.5m)		\$59.95
Acer Mirte – Warm orange-red Spring leaf, unique colour to the maples. Changing to a soft brown then a shining green for Summer & Golden orange in the Autumn. Vigorous grower. A wonderful series of unique colour to the garden. (3mx2m)		\$65.00
Acer Moss Gold - Deeply dissected leaves of a wonderful, mossy-gold colour in spring, picking up greener tinges in summer. Followed by oranges and reds in autumn. Lovely red stems contrast boldly with gold foliage. (1mx1m)		\$78.00
Acer Negundo Kelly's Gold - Golden-yellow spring leaves that are lime-green through summer, turning to a pale-yellow in autumn. Has a neat, upright growth habit that will lighten up dark areas. A hardy & quick-growing maple. (6mx4m)		From \$58.00

Acer Okagami - Intense-red leaves in spring that are large turn to a glossy, purple-black in summer, & fiery scarlet in autumn. This maple is a robust, upright grower. It prefers moist, well-drained soils, but may suffer from leaf scorch due to excess sun, wind, and drought. It is cold hardy and great for bonsai. (4mx3m)		\$65.00
Acer Osakasuki – An all-time favourite! New growth is a pinky bronze that turns green. Considered to have the brightest scarlet Autumn colours. A small robust upright spreader. (4mx3m)		\$65.00
Acer Red Dragon - Delicate dissected red foliage through spring and summer intensifying to scarlet red in autumn. Lovely feature plant that will provide a soft cascading effect. Equally looks very graceful in a container. (1mx1.5m)		\$78.00
Acer Rubrum - A rapid growing maple with a broadly rounded crown and excellent Autumn tones of bright scarlet. Water well to establish & maximise growth. Prefers moist soils but will tolerate swampy soils. (10mx5m)		From \$49.95
Acer Russet Lace - New weeping maple with wonderful russet colours of yellow/gold, and orange/red. Green tones intensify in summer. Autumn colour is a mix of orange & red. (1.5mx1m)		\$78.00
Acer saccharum – (Sugar Maple) - North American variety with broadly columnar shape & from which spring sap can be processed into maple syrup. Large upward sweeping tree worthy of planting where space allows. Great Autumn colour with shades of orange & red. (10mx8m)		From \$39.95

Acer Seiryu - (Lace leaf maple) – Upright growing with finely dissected green foliage clothing gracefully arching branches. Autumn colours are soft yellows to gold. (3mx2.5m)		From \$49.95
Acer Senkaki - The main feature of this Maple is the fiery coral red colour of the branches & twigs that are a real stand out in winter when the tree is bare. The green summer foliage turns golden yellow in autumn. (2mx2m)		From \$69.95
Acer Shaina – A dwarf maple that will grow happily in a container or small garden. The branches & leaves are an attractive wine red which deepens slightly in Autumn. Good compact upright habit. Happiest in the sun or semi-shade with protection from harsh winds. (2mx2m)		\$59.95
Acer Shindeshojo - This compact Japanese maple has dainty foliage with outstanding, flaming-scarlet spring leaves that turn a blended green-pink in summer and go a flaming-scarlet again in autumn. (3mx2m)	1.2m	From \$59.95
Acer Shishigashira - A slow growing Maple, commonly called the Lion's Head Maple as the dense tufts of crinkled foliage on each branch resemble the mane of a lion. The bright green leaves turn golden orange in autumn. (3mx3m)		\$59.95
Acer Stella Rossa - A graceful cultivar with weeping branches becoming mound-like with age. The delicate, filigree-like leaves unfold bright-red in spring, retaining their beautiful colour into summer then becoming dark burgundy before turning bright red with orange undertones in autumn. Acer Tsuma-Gaki - (The Finger-Painted Lady Maple) - Medium sized maple; pale yellow green leaves edged at the tips with red giving an unusual contrast and two-toned look. By mid-summer the leaves go deep green with a hint of bronze on the tips. (6mx4m)		\$65.00
Acer Ueno Yama - Japanese Maple. An upright form with lobed leaves that have distinctive orange tones as they emerge in spring. Gradually the leaves mature to a pale green. Orange-red in autumn. (3mx3m)		\$59.95
Aesculus carnea – Red Horse Chestnut – Strikingly beautiful rounded tree with masses of pink flowers in late Spring. Large dark green leaves divided into fan shapes. Suits a moist position. (10mx7m)		From \$65.00
Albizzia Red Silk - If you want to sit under soft ferny foliage and look up at fuzzy fluffy carmine red flowers then this is the tree for you. Very pretty specimen tree with a single trunk and good shade canopy. Red flowers during Summer. Quite quick growing. (5mx4m)		\$69.95
Albizzia j. Rosea (Silk Tree) - This is a fabulous quick growing tree with a single stem & a good shade canopy making it ideal to relax under. Soft ferny foliage & fluffy fuzzy blooms in warm pink that appear in summer. (5mx4m)		FROM \$69.95

Betula jacquemontii - This birch tree is beautiful and features dazzling white peeling bark that extends from top to bottom & remains even as the tree ages. Its growth habit is neat and erect, and its large tapering dark-green leaves turn a bright yellow colour during the autumn season. This species is deciduous and native to the Western Himalayas. (8mx4m)		\$59.95
Betula pendula - Very popular for its white barked trunk & graceful branching habit. Fast growing beautiful tree that is suited to most average garden conditions. (8mx5m)		From \$39.95
Betula White Spire – (Himalayan Birch) – A selected for of this special tree that has a glistening white trunk of peeling bark. The dark green foliage has serrated edges and turns warm yellow in autumn. 'White Spire' tends to have a very upright columnar habit. (8mx4m)		\$89.95
Carpinus betulus - Strong growing pyramidal tree highly suited to pleaching or trimming for an interesting feature hedge. Can be pruned quite heavily. Deciduous but retains leaves into Winter. (15mx10m)		From \$46.95
Carpinus betulus Fastigiata - A rather special Hornbeam variety with a naturally upright narrow growth habit. Can still be used for hedging but forms a stylish naturally upright tree for restricted areas or accessways. A tough deciduous tree handling damper & drier soils. (12mx6m)		From \$46.95
Cedrela sinensis Flamingo - The slender, erect branches bear pinnate leaves of rich warm-pink in early-spring. Leaves become cream pink & mature to green by summer. Orange-yellow autumn leaves. (4m x 3m)		From \$49.95
Cercidiphyllum japonicum “pendulum” – A special deciduous tree with aromatic foliage. The emerging spring leaves are shaded in tones of reddish-bronze before turning a deep green over Summer. Cercis can. Forest Pansy – An attractive small deciduous tree with an interesting branch formation. In spring these branches are covered in tiny, hot pink blossoms. The wow factor continues when the deep maroon foliage appears. (4mx3m)		\$79.95

Cornus Alba Siberica - A spreading shrub with dark-green leaves that provide great autumn colour in shades of orange and red, then drop to expose brilliant red stems in winter. Clusters of small creamy white flowers in summer. Best stem colour is in full sun. (2m)		From \$59.95
Cornus Cherokee Daybreak - This Dogwood is valued for the decorative variegated foliage. The fresh green leaves are attractively margined in creamy white with just a hint of pink in spring. The flower bracts are showy and white. Excellent autumn colour. (3.5mx3.5m)		\$63.00
Cornus 'China Girl' - is a vigorous grower and produces a profusion of flowers at a very early age. The small flowers start out as lime green & gradually mature and enlarge into four-petalled, snow-white flowers in early summer. (4mx3m)		From \$59.95
Cornus Cloud 9 – This Cornus produces a profusion of pure white large flower bracts that appear in spring on this lovely tree. More tolerant of heat than many other Cornus and all together strong and vigorous. The dark green summer foliage colours well prior to leaf fall. (3mx2.5m)		\$63.00
Cornus contraversa Variegata - This unique & special Cornus is highly valued for the unusual layered structure of its branches giving it the common name of 'The Wedding Cake Tree'. Cornus Satomi – Is vigorous grower & becomes smothered with large, flat, four-petalled, pink-red, star-shaped flowers in Early Summer, creating a beautiful display. Cornus Stokes Pink - This strong-growing tree has an ascending branch structure that adds to its visual appeal. In the spring, 'Stoke's Pink' is covered in rich-pink, four-petalled flowers, which are a sight to behold. It flowers particularly well in warmer regions. During autumn, the leaves turn into rich shades of red and purple, which persist well into the winter, making it a great choice for a year-round display. Magnolia Amethyst Flame - Raised in NZ by Vance Hooper this hybrid will flower from a young age. Its growth habit is shrub like but with upright growing branches. The spring flowers are large & a rich deep violet red shade. Dark green foliage. (3mx2.5m)		From \$59.95
Magnolia Athene - A NZ bred Magnolia of exceptional quality with large thick textured blooms of white blushed with pink at the base. Starts flowering at approximately 3 years of age. (7mx3.5m)		From \$59.95
Magnolia Billowing Cloud - Bred in the Land of the Long White Cloud 'Billowing Cloud' has distinctive white blooms with just a soft blush of rose pink at the base of the petals. The blooms sit up nicely on the bare branches and have quite a strong fragrance. Plant in a sheltered spot in acid soil. (3mx2.5m)		\$59.95
Magnolia Black Tulip – Bred in NZ by renowned breeder Mark Jury, this stunning Magnolia has large cup shaped blooms of an exceptionally dark-ruby red. Generous with bloom from a young age & a vigorous grower. Plant in a sunny sheltered position. (6mx4m)		\$79.95
Magnolia Charles Raffill – A Magnolia with all the right heritage as it was raised at Kew Gardens in the 40's. The buds are a seductive blush rose pink. The blooms are large & fragrant. (7mx5m)	1.4M	FROM \$48.00

Magnolia Serene - Produces large, rounded, bowl-shaped flowers in a deep rose-pink colour with ivory-white interiors. The blooms are slightly fragrant & last for a long period during mid to late spring. "Serene" starts blooming at a young age.	From \$55.00
Magnolia Sir Harold Hillier - During late winter to early spring, Magnolia 'Sir Harold Hillier' produces large, goblet-shaped flowers that are pure white in colour. These flowers can reach a width of up to 30cm. Magnolia 'Sir Harold Hillier' itself has a broad, conical shape. (5mx3m)	\$59.95
Magnolia Star Wars - One of the most spectacular & long flowering Magnolias with large, star shaped flowers of rose pink with blush white interiors. A hardy hybrid. Very popular. (5mx4m)	\$59.95

Magnolia stellata Waterlily - Awarded an Award of Garden Merit in 1993 this is a lovely deciduous shrub that is quite vigorous and hardy. The silky pink buds open to reveal white shaggy star shaped flowers set against attractive bare branches. Fresh, dark green foliage follows. (3mx2m)	\$59.95
Magnolia stellata Wildcat - This is a stronger growing stellata type due to it's mixed parentage with Magnolia kobus. Well-formed white fully double flowers with narrow tepals make this a very attractive large bush or small tree. (3mx2m)	\$59.95

Malus Crab-apple

The crab apple is one of those rare, catch-all trees that tick not one but all the boxes on the gardener's checklist. It all starts in spring with a riot of blousy white or pink blossom that draws in the pollinators as they stir from their winter slumber. They are ready to pick from early autumn and, just as the spring blossom draws in the bees, any fruits left on the tree into winter serve as a beacon to birds.

Malus Floribunda - A smaller growing, ornamental tree with long gracefully arching branches. In spring the whole tree becomes covered with bright pink buds opening to white to pale pink flowers. Yellow fruits flushed red soon follow which can be eaten but birds also enjoy. (3mx2.5m)		\$59.95
