Acer “Katsura” - The dainty, new spring leaves emerge pale yellow with hints of orange and red before slowly turning green over summer. In autumn the yellow and orange tones are once again to the fore prior to leaf fall. (2.5m x 2.5m)		
Acer Lace Lady - Feathery foliage that emerges burgundy red in the spring and is known for holding its red colour right through the summer taking on a vibrant crimson red in autumn. (1.5mx1m)		From \$78.00
Acer “Mikawa Yatsubusa” - A naturally dwarf growing variety, multi-stemmed with dense, overlapping foliage. In spring, the new leaves are yellow-green in colour then darkening as they mature and in autumn they turn to bright shades of orange and scarlet. Acer “Mirte” - An attractive little Japanese Maple with a wide upright habit growing as wide as it is high. Chocolate-brown leaves in spring turning bronze-green in summer then orange autumn tones. Perfect for a sheltered spot in small gardens. (3m x 3m)		From \$69.95

Acer “Shaina” - A dwarf maple that will grow happily in a container or small garden. The branches & leaves are an attractive wine red which deepens slightly in Autumn. Good compact upright habit. Happiest in the sun or semi-shade with protection from harsh winds. (2mx2m)			\$74.95
Acer “Shiraz” - An unusual little Maple with multi-toned variegated foliage. When the new leaves first emerge in Spring, they are a striking crimson, pink, as they mature, they turn to olive green and silver. Excellent fiery red tones in autumn. Happiest protected from afternoon sun and strong wind. (2.5m x 2m)			From \$64.95
Acer “Skeeters Broom” - Excellent small garden tree with outstanding brilliant red & shrimp pink spring foliage in spring that slowly turns green. In autumn the leaves are once again all fired up in shades of red. Best in morning sun or semi-shade & out of strong wind. (2m x 2m)			\$74.95

Acer Viridis - If you want a weeping maple then this is one of the best. Intricate & delicate soft fresh green foliage on graceful pendulous branches. The autumn tones are gold & yellow. Aesculus hippocastanum – (Horse Chestnut) - If you want a game of Conkers then this is the tree for you. The 'Horse Chestnut' is a handsome large tree with bold foliage and huge white, tinged red flowers in spring. The flowers are followed by nuts encased in a distinctive prickly skin. The nuts known as 'conkers' are released in Autumn. (7m x 5m)	1m		From \$74.95
Albizzia Red Silk - If you want to sit under soft ferny foliage and look up at fuzzy fluffy carmine red flowers then this is the tree for you. Very pretty specimen tree with a single trunk and good shade canopy. Red flowers during Summer. Quite quick growing. (5mx4m)			\$69.95
Albizzia Rosea - (Silk Tree) - This is a fabulous quick growing tree with a single stem & a good shade canopy making it ideal to relax under. Soft ferny foliage & fluffy fuzzy blooms in warm pink that appear in summer. (5mx4m)			\$69.95
Alnus Cordata “Italian Alder” - Extremely tolerant, fast-growing tree that loves moisture. Attractive heart shaped leaves that are green and glossy. The male flower catkins appear before the leaves and the female flowers develop into small woody cones. (10m x 6m)			From \$49.95
Amelanchier canadensis - (Shad Bush) - A neat, erect growing shrub or small tree with young leaves commencing almost white then mid green over summer becoming vibrant shades of red, yellow and orange in autumn. Betula “Dazzler” - This 'dazzling' Himalayan birch has gorgeous pure white, peeling bark & large (for a birch) green leaves that turn a lovely shade of gold in Autumn. Calycanthus “Hartlage Wine” - This is an interesting deciduous shrub with rich green, slightly glossy leaves and interesting magnolia-like flowers from early to mid-summer on the tips of short spurs with the new growth. The flowers are a rich maroon-red-brown colour. (2.5m)			From \$49.95

Carpinus betulus – (“ European Hornbeam ”) Attractive oval green ribbed foliage that has good autumn tones before turning brown. The leaves hold on the tree well into Winter. Smooth grey bark, ornamental catkins in spring followed by ornamental winged seed 'nuts'. Can be trimmed as a low hedge. (15m x 10m)		From \$49.95
Carpinus betulus Fastigiata - A rather special Hornbeam variety with a naturally upright narrow growth habit. Can still be used for hedging but forms a stylish naturally upright tree for restricted areas or accessways. A tough deciduous tree handling damper & drier soils. (12mx6m)		From \$49.95
Cedrela sinensis “Toon Tree” - The 'Toon' tree is all about the fabulous foliage which emerges in early spring. Initially the leaves are bright shrimp pink, gradually turning to bright green. Strong upright growth. Protect from wind. (4m x 3m)		From \$54.00
Cercidiphyllum japonicum “pendulum” – A special deciduous tree with aromatic foliage. The emerging spring leaves are shaded in tones of reddish-bronze before turning a deep green over Summer. Cornus Alba Siberica - A spreading shrub with dark-green leaves that provide great autumn colour in shades of orange and red, then drop to expose brilliant red stems in winter. Clusters of small creamy white flowers in summer. Best stem colour is in full sun. (2m)		From \$59.95
Cornus Cherokee Chief - A stunning rose red flowering Cornus. Attractive green leaves turn orange, red, yellow & purple in autumn. A beautiful addition to any space, popular as a specimen tree on patios & lawns. Best in well-drained soil in sun or partial shade. (6m x 3m)		From \$69.95

Cotinus “Grace” – (Smoke Bush) - A beautiful foliage shrub with new spring leaves emerging with crimson purple tones aging to green with a purple tinge as summer progresses & once again deepening in tone prior to leaf fall. The frothy cloud of pink flowers appears in Summer. Easy to grow, healthy and hardy. (2.5m x 2.5m)	40cm	\$59.95
Cotinus cog. purpurea ‘Royal Purple’ - A selected form with stunning wine purple colour foliage. This lovely colour is retained until the autumn then it turns to shades of orange and scarlet. Plumes of pinky grey flowers appear mid-Summer & stand like a smoky haze above the foliage. Responds well to pruning. (4m x 2m)	40cm	\$59.95
Fagus syl. “Purple Fountain” – (Weeping Purple European Beech) has a columnar shape with cascading side branches. Its beautiful bronze-purple-black foliage changes throughout the seasons. New dark red leaves in the spring then deepen to bronze-purple-black by summer. Come autumn, the leaves change to an orange-brown, before falling in winter. Wavy margined leaves. Fraxinus Raywoodii - (Claret Ash) A deservedly popular & beautiful deciduous tree. Elegant branch framework, neat pyramidal habit & handsome long narrow foliage. Ginkgo Biloba - A large handsome specimen tree famous for its gorgeous golden Autumn foliage. Tolerant of heat or cold, but, keep moist until established. (10mx8m)	1.5m	From \$65.00

Ginkgo “Jade Butterflies” - This pyramidal tree features jade-green foliage that adds a vibrant and attractive look to the landscape. Liquidambar “Burgundy” – This is a selected clone with a narrower, pyramidal form when young, which broadens with age. It features larger maple-shaped leaves that emerge earlier than other cultivars. In the autumn, the leaves turn a rich, red-burgundy colour, which persists well into winter, providing seasonal interest it is known to colour well in all climates & is an excellent choice for use as a street tree. Liriodendron “Arnold” - A very special deciduous tree with a upright columnar (fastigiata) habit. The distinctive fresh green foliage is large and lobed and turns a warm golden yellow in autumn. The summer flowers are also most distinctive - tulip shaped, fragrant and coloured green with an orange base. (8m x 5m)		\$79.95
Liriodendron “Snowbird” - Tulip Tree. A variegated form with foliage being a mix of dark green and cream-white markings of varying shapes and sizes around the edges. Produce tulip-shaped flowers that are the palest of yellow and salmon-orange banding that emerge in early Summer. They are hardy and make an excellent feature/ specimen tree that also provides good shade during the warmer months. Thrives in full sun or partial shade where soils are moist and free-draining. Magnolia ‘Athene’ - A NZ-bred Magnolia of exceptional quality with large thick, textured blooms of white, blushed with pink at the base. Starts flowering at approximately 3 years of age. (7mx3.5m)		From \$65.00
Magnolia “Billowing Cloud” - Bred in NZ 'Billowing Cloud' has distinctive white blooms with just a soft blush of rose pink at the base of the petals. The blooms sit up nicely on the bare branches and have quite a strong fragrance. (3mx2.5m)		From \$65.00
Magnolia Black Tulip - Bred in NZ by renowned breeder Mark Jury, this stunning Magnolia has large cup shaped blooms of an exceptionally dark-ruby red. Generous with bloom from a young age & a vigorous grower. Plant in a sunny sheltered position. (6mx4m)		\$79.95
Magnolia “Brixton Belle” - An exciting Magnolia bred in Taranaki. Flower buds form after the 1st year of planting and open to large rich pink blooms with a soft inner blush. Breath taking in full bloom and worthy of a place in any garden. (4m x 3.5m)		\$79.95
Magnolia “Cleopatra” - “Cleopatra” is a compact, upright deciduous magnolia, admired for its large, goblet-shaped, cerise-purple flowers with a glossy sheen. Blooming in mid-to-late spring, the flowers often continue into early summer, creating a bold display. (4m x 3m)		\$79.95

Magnolia "Serene" - Large, deep rose, bowl shaped blooms stand out on naked branches in early spring. Yet another winner from the Jury family of New Plymouth who are world leaders in Magnolia breeding. As with most of their hybrids, flowers from a young age. Happiest in a sunny sheltered spot. (5m x 4m)		From \$75.00
Magnolia "Sir Harold Hillier" - Named after the eminent British horticulturist this form of M. campbellii has huge bowl-shaped flowers of pure white. It will take quite a few years to mature to its outstanding best but as the saying goes good things do indeed take time. Plant in a sheltered position. (7m x 5m)		From \$59.95
Magnolia Strawberry Fields - NZ hybrid with vibrant red blooms in the shape of a large star. Flowers for a long period in late winter spring. Develops into an upright columnar tree. (5mx3m)		From \$65.00
Magnolia "Vulcan" - The flowers are deep wine- pink and beautifully cupped. A magnificent specimen tree. Will perform its best protected from harsh wind. A firm favourite. (5m x 4m)		From \$75.00
Magnolia stellata Jane Platt - An award-winning Magnolia and deservedly so. A small, multi branched shrub. Produces spectacular double, scented, pale pink flowers with long, narrow petals in early to mid-spring. Flowers gradually fade to white. Prefers full sun or part shade. Magnolia stellata King Rose - This little sweetie is ideal for those of you with small gardens or for filling a little corner. Masses of soft pink buds open to white blooms with a hint of pink at the base. Flowers in Spring. (2m x 2m)	80cm	From \$59.95

<u>Malus Crab-apple</u>		
<i>The crab apple is one of those rare, catch-all trees that tick not one but all the boxes on the gardener's checklist. It all starts in spring with a riot of blousy white or pink blossom that draws in the pollinators as they stir from their winter slumber. They are ready to pick from early autumn and, just as the spring blossom draws in the bees, any fruits left on the tree into winter serve as a beacon to birds.</i>		
Malus Floribunda - A smaller growing, ornamental tree with long gracefully arching branches. In spring the whole tree becomes covered with bright pink buds opening to white to pale pink flowers. Yellow fruits flushed red soon follow which can be eaten but birds also enjoy. (3mx2.5m) 2m + on 1.5m Standard - \$84.95		
Malus "Golden Hornet" Pink buds open to pale pink blossom in spring. The blossom is followed by heavy crops of little golden yellow apples that almost cover the branches in autumn-winter. Upright pyramidal habit. Easy to grow in a well-drained sunny spot. (3mx2.5m)		From \$59.95
Malus Ioensis Plena - Large, double, frilly pink, fragrant blossoms decorate the tree in late Spring. The summer foliage is a soft sage green & also very decorative. (3mx2m)	1.6m-1.7m High on 1.5m Standard - \$94.95	Low Worked - \$69.95
Malus Jack Humm - The single white blossom in spring is followed by large shiny red 'apples' that stand out on the bare branches right through winter. (3mx2m)		From \$64.95
Malus Wright's Scarlet - Beautiful white blossom in spring followed by a plentiful supply of large crimson fruits that hang on the tree through winter. Wine coloured summer foliage. (3mx3m)		From \$64.95

Morus Alba Pendula – Is a spectacular tree has large, glossy-green leaves and produces sweet, oval, white fruit that ripen to deep-pink, dark-red, or purple-black during the summer months.
