ALMONDS

All in One – This Almond that is highly recommended for home orchards. Produces heavy crops of soft-shell nuts with a sweet flavour. Almonds blossom in late winter around about August and for this reason it is good to plant them in a sheltered position where the blossom won't get damaged by strong winds or heavy frost. **\$59.95**

Mono Vale – Mono Vale produces hard-shell nuts with good flavour. Due to their strong flavour this variety can be used for Marzipan. A heavy cropper & good pollinator. Disease hardy variety. Vigorous grower. Self-Fertile **\$59.95**

APPLES

This selection of apples is on MM106 rootstock - semi-dwarfing stock (3-3.5m). This rootstock is vigorous, resistant to woolly aphid

Braeburn - Crisp, firm & juicy with yellowish green skin that is broadly striped with red. Sweet flavour balanced with a moderate tartness for just a little zing. Self-fertile.

Cox's Orange - One of the finest apples ever grown. Greenish-yellow skin with Orange-red striping. Rich, aromatic nutty flavour makes this older variety still hugely popular. Suitable for cooking or eating. Self-fertile.

Divine - A red skinned apple with crisp, crunchy, juicy flesh with a firm texture. The tree itself has been bred for strong resistance to disease and is a perfect choice for organic gardens. Stores well for 3-4 months in the fridge.

Fuji – A Japanese variety with large fruit with a smooth red-shaded skin. The creamy white flesh is firm, juicy & sweet with a satisfying crunch when eaten fresh. Stores exceptionally well. Ripens from mid-Autumn onwards.

Gala – Crisp, crunchy white juicy flesh that is aromatic & tastes divine. Nice red blush to the yellow skin. Ripens in Summer around February.

Golden Delicious – The flesh is crisp & juicy with a sweet honey flavour. Lovely eaten fresh but can be cooked. Highly productive & ripen towards the end of Autumn.

Granny Smith - Everyone's favourite! This classic bright green apple with its tangy flavour & crisp white flesh is suitable for eating or cooking. Keeps well. Very productive.

Lady in Red - Luscious & flavoursome oblong fruit. A hardy grower, useful as a fruiting screen or hedge plant. It tolerates poor and exposed conditions.

Red Delicious - Classic, heart shaped, red shiny fruit. The perfumed, sweet & crispy flesh invites you to take one big delicious bite after another. Can be eaten straight off the tree or is ideal for pies and puddings.

Royal Gala - One of NZ's most popular eating apples. Rosy red blushed skin. Creamy, fine textured flesh, crisp, sweet & juicy.

CIDER APPLES – from \$59.95

Kingston Black - Heritage Apple. Now if you like Cider and why wouldn't you then this apple is a 'must have'.

Valued for producing a slow-fermenting, full-bodied, quality 'hard' cider. The fruit are small, dark and maroon in colour with a 'bitter sharp' flavour. Note this is not an eating apple.

Mother In-Law - Arguably the most famous English bitter sharp cider apple. Makes a distinctively flavoured cider without blending although often included in blends.

Slack Ma Girdle - Slack ma Girdle are medium size, flat, yellow green with bright red patches. Late ripening. They are a sweet cider apple, also good for eating. They make a rich, full-bodied cider.

DWARF APPLES

This selection of Apples are on m27 rootstock – (dwarf rootstock)

& grow to approx. 2m-3m. \$59.95 unless noted

Braeburn - Crisp, firm & juicy with yellowish green skin that is broadly striped with red. sweet flavour balanced with a moderate tartness for just a little zing. Self-fertile.

Cox's Orange - One of the finest apples ever grown. Greenish-yellow skin with Orange-red striping. Rich, aromatic nutty flavour makes this older variety still hugely popular. Suitable for cooking or eating. Self-fertile.

Granny Smith - Everyone's favourite! This classic bright green apple with its tangy flavour & crisp white flesh is suitable for eating or cooking. Keeps well. Very productive.

Royal Gala - One of NZ's most popular eating apples. Rosy red blushed skin. Creamy, fine textured flesh, crisp, sweet & juicy.

APRICOTS

Fitzroy - Bred in Taranaki, consistent crops of medium sized golden fruit that ripen around February. Copes well in warmer climates. Self-fertile.

Garden Annie – Is an early season fruiting variety, with good sized bright yellow fruit that are firm & juicy as well as being semi-freestone. A highly ornamental tree that is semi-dwarf.

Moorpark - Soft, juicy, 'fuzz less' fruit of superb quality with a luscious flavour. Suitable for fresh eating straight off the tree but can also be bottled or dried. Likes a warm sunny position but is very cold tolerant. Self-fertile.

Royal Rosa - Royal Rosa is a very early, freestone selection with firm tasty gold flesh, yellow skin with a red blush. A disease hardy, low chill selection recommended for home gardens throughout New Zealand. Self-fertile.

Trevatt - Large, sweet, and juicy, this golden yellow fruit ripens mid to late in season. Perfect for eating as well as bottling, this variety is recommended for most areas. Self-fertile.

Thornless - Beautiful dark berry fruit ripening over Summer. A strong growing thorn free cultivar, ideal for fences or tee pee. Best when grown in a sunny, sheltered position and rich acidic soil.

BLUEBERRIES

Partially self-fertile but pollination is assisted with correct pollinator.

Choose any two different varieties for pollination. Varieties will vary during the season.

Blue Dawn - This 'rabbit-eye' variety produces masses of large, tasty & delicious fruit. Generally, fruits from December through to February. Pollinate with another rabbit-eye.

Blue Magic – This 'rabbit-eye' variety produces copious amounts of delicious medium sized fruit. Thinning Of the fruit will encourage larger berries. Fruits December to February.

Blue Muffin - A variety that produces heavy crops of medium sized fruit that you can harvest in and around December, then again in March and April. Powder Blue - The sweet berries are of a good size & high quality & produced in generous quantities between January & March.

Tasty Blue - Rounded deep blue juicy berries, preceded by pink-tinged white flowers in spring. A spreading to an upright growth habit, with bronze autumn-winter toning's. This variety is suitable for all regions in New Zealand, either in the garden or as a container plant.

BOYSENBERRIES

Priced from \$26.95

Brulee - White flowers appear in spring and will be followed by large firm conical dark purple fruit. Boysenberry

Brulee is moderately vigorous, mostly spineless canes. Fruit should be ready February & March (late season).

Starlight - White flowers appear in spring, followed by large firm conical dark wine purple fruit of excellent flavour. Moderately vigorous with thornless canes. Harvest time is December and January (early season) with heavy yields if well cared for.

Tasman is almost thornless. Fruit ripens December through to January. Growth similar to raspberries. Needs support for the long canes. Prune by removing canes that have fruited to ground level.

Thornless – Beautiful dark berry fruit ripening over Summer. A strong growing, thorn free cultivar.

Thornless Jewel – This plant produces rich dark red/black berries with a delightfully aromatic old fashioned boysenberry flavour.

ELDERBERRIES

They are attractive & easy to grow. Ideal for the home gardener. Elderberries contain more phosphorus & potassium than any other temperate fruit crop. **Self-fertile - \$32.50**

GOOSEBERRIES

Invicta – Heavy bearing, with large flavourful fruit that can be used for culinary purposes or eating when fully ripe. **\$44.00**

Pax – Is a red dessert gooseberry. The fruit are large, red, round & one of the best gooseberries you will ever eat. **\$44.00**

MULBERRY

Black Mulberry has sweet, intense, blackish red fruit which mature in late spring/early summer. Quite juicy.

Good flavour. Lovely heart shaped, glossy green leaves dress the well-shaped ornamental tree. Quite easy to grow in a sunny position. **\$39.95**

White Mulberry - Morus Alba Pendula - Desirable, weeping form. The glossy large heart shaped leaves always look fresh. Small edible fruits appear in spring and are loved by humans & birds alike. **\$89.95**

RASPBERRIES

Priced from only \$19.95 – All are self-fertile

More varieties will be available during the season.

Aspiring – Raspberry Aspiring has a large dark red conical firm fruit with an excellent flavour. This raspberry is a dual cropper meaning that as well as fruiting in summer, it will also fruit in autumn. This divine raspberry grows as a bramble on upright canes. They are covered with rose-type leaves. Small white flowers are followed by luscious, sweet, delicate fruit. Vigorous and productive plant, which spreads fast and is one of the easiest of all to grow. Produces a high number of strong upright canes. Dormant canes are dark brown with few spines.

Kaituna – Vigorous & productive plant, which spreads fast and is one of the easiest of all to grow.

Canes are vigorous, with a high number of strong upright canes. Harvest is early season, Dec-Jan.

Lewis - High yields of large firm medium, sweet, red fruit. Plant has few spines and it is of medium vigour. Best in a sunny spot and rich soil. Prune back to fresh buds in late winter.

CHERRY TREES

This Selection of Cherry Trees are on a Colt Rootstock & should grow to approximately 4m. \$63.00 each

Burlatt - Sweet Cherry. High quality First cherry of the season maturing late Nov— early Dec. Large heart shaped fruit with juicy soft sweet dark red flesh. Use fresh, jams, jellies, preserves or dessert.

Compact Stella – Sweet & productive. This tree bears plump, bold-red cherries that are delicious! Grow abundant crops of heart-shaped fruit! **Self-fertile.**

Lapins - Sweet Cherry. This heritage variety of Cherry is one of the largest and juiciest with firm dark red fruit that are sweet & delicious. Good resistance to skin splitting & a reliable producer. Ripens Mid-late season. **Self-fertile**

Rainier - Sweet Cherry - A cross between Bing & Van cherry varieties the combination of these two red cherries produced a golden yellow cherry with a red blush & incredibly sweet flavour. Large white fleshed midseason cherry. Excellent eating. **Pollinator – Dawson**

Stella - Sweet Cherry. A very popular commercial variety that can be grown in the home orchard. Large, dark, black-red, heart-shaped cherries that ripen in December and taste absolutely delicious. Prolific and regular crops. Plant in a sunny spot. **Self-Fertile**

Summit - Summit is an early to mid-season dark red cherry bred in Canada, ripening around Christmas. It is a very large flat heart-shaped fruit with excellent flavour. Has dark red skin, light red, juicy flesh. **Self-Fertile**

CHESTNUTS

Castanea 1005 - Commercial fruiting variety. Large, red-brown nuts fall free of the burr. A heavy-cropper bearing nuts in early-autumn. Strong, upright-grower. **Self-fertile. \$64.95**

CITRUS

GRAPEFRUIT – From \$42.95

Cutler's Red - has large, deep orange, sweet, juicy fruit with just a little zing. The rind is thick.

Golden Special - has large juicy seedless fruit. Ideal for breakfast fruit, juicing & also makes delicious Marmalade.

Morrison Seedless - The hardiest all-purpose citrus tree producing medium to large, round, thin skinned, moderately sweet, juicy fruit, maturing August. Holds well on tree. Vigorous, large & prolific bearer.

Wheneey - This Australian variety has large, good quality, pale yellow fruit. The fruit has thin skin & very juicy flesh with a mild flavour. More suited for juicing.

LEMONS – From \$42.95

Lemonade – An interesting fast-growing Hybrid lemon which has medium sized pale-yellow fruit. Easy to peel, mild flavour. Excellent for Summer drinks.

Lisbon – One for the lemon connoisseur, deliciously juicy, fragrant fruit with a thick skin. Very productive & vigorous.

Meyer – N Z's most popular lemon & deservedly so. The clean, dark green foliage forms a medium sized plant with waxy white fragrant flowers, which appear in Spring, Summer & Autumn. The tree will produce tasty, juicy lemons.

Villa Franca - Thornless & a smaller tree than Lisbon. Prolific & bears a heavy crop.

Yen Ben – Profuse producer of large oval shaped fruit with a distinctive sharp acidic flavour. Very juicy & has few seeds. The skin is fragrant & firm.

LIMES– From \$42.95

Bearr's - A citrus tree known for its fruit, ornamental foliage & fragrant flowers, 'Bearr's is related to the Tahitian lime. It is neat & compact in habit & almost thornless tree. Its fruit are small, thin skinned, deep green-turning yellow with seedless, juicy tangy flesh.

Kaffir - Great for Thai cooking & have long been used for their leaves that are finely cut up & fruit for its zest, in Thai food. They add a distinctive flavour to any meal.

Sublime – Exciting Tahitian variety with lower seed content & prolific fruiting habit. Large, thin skinned juicy fruit.

Tahitian - The fruit are smooth & lime to yellow in colour and are high in Vitamin 'C.'

MANDARINS– From \$42.95

- Afourer** – It develops a highly attractive deep orange-red colour & is easy to peel. It is a very flavoursome.
- Burgess Scarlet** –Medium sized, rich flavoured, aromatic fruit that is easy to peel. The fruit is mature from June - August. Quite vigorous in habit but nice & bushy.
- Clementine** – A popular early maturing variety that has small, sweet juicy fruit of good colour & flavour.
- Encore** - These Mandarins' fruit from Nov-Feb. The fruit are medium in size & easy to peel, sweet & juicy.
- Kiyomi** - A hybrid citrus fruit of mandarin & sweet orange. Fruit is large like an orange, thick skinned & easy to peel. Flesh is juicy & seedless. Satsuma type ripening August-September.
- Miho** - 'Miho' is very early ripening with fruit ready to eat from April/May. The easy peel, flat fruit has a mild sweet taste.
- Satsuma** - Is a popular, sweet, seedless, easy peel variety. Best picked as the fruit becomes puffy, when left on tree. Ideal for the lunchbox.

ORANGES– From \$42.95

- Best Seedless** – A good quality NZ orange with sweet & juicy, seedless fruit. Ripens from September onwards. Chock full of Vitamin C. Blood Orange - A natural pigment not usually present in citrus, changes the colour of the flesh to a crimson-blood red colour. The fruits are small-medium sized.
- Harwood Late** - produces thin skinned, juicy oranges with an excellent flavour that ripen from Autumn onwards. Good vigorous upright habit.
- Parent Navel** – This kiwi classic has a light orange skin; excellent flavour & its flesh is juicy sweet. While in flower its blossoms emit a gorgeous fragrance. Good vigorous upright habit.
- Seville** - Very old variety, very sour. Ideal for marmalades & preserves. July to September

CURRANTS

Priced from \$19.95

- Laxton Tinker – Black currant** - A heritage English selection with consistent and heavy crops around the end of the year. Good disease resistance. Water well during hot dry periods. Sun - part shade.
- Red-** A smallish bush which can be easily squeezed into a small garden as a hedging border or as a standalone specimen.

FEIJOA'S

Varieties may vary during the season. If there is a particular variety that you are after – please inquire. Any two different varieties will pollinate each other - From \$19.95 each

- Apollo** - Fruit are medium to large size with excellent flavour. Vigorous upright growth habit.
- Den's Choice** – An early season variety with medium to large, sweet flavoured fruit. Ready to harvest in April/May.
- Golden Goose** - Large, smooth, king-sized fruit. Sweet, golden-yellow flesh. Fruits from late-autumn to early winter. Has an extra-long shelf-life for the fruit. Rounded, bushy grower. Beautiful red flowers from late-spring to mid-summer.
- Mammoth** – Strong upright growing with large fruit. Thick skin & excellent flavour. Prolific. Matures early to mid season. Ideal for growing as a specimen tree & ideal for hedging.
- Pounamu** - One of the best feijoas for taste, with a rich, smooth aromatic flavour. Early cropper with dark-green skin, almost the colour of greenstone. Ripens April/May.
- Sellowiana Giant** - Luscious & flavoursome oblong fruit. A hardy grower, useful as a fruiting screen or hedge plant. Ideal as a hedge. Prefers free draining conditions.
- Unique** - Large crops of medium-sized fruit with soft, smooth & juicy flesh. Crops from a younger age than other Feijoa cultivars. Early season, ripens April.
- White Goose** - This large, vigorous growing Feijoa produces a heavy crop of large with semi-smooth light green skin around April-May.

FIGS

These selections should grow to Approximately 3-4 metres.

All priced at \$49.95 each unless noted.

Brown Turkey - This fruiting fig is highly ornamental as well as productive. Large glossy green foliage & a vigorous growth habit with large fruit that are purplish brown with pink flesh & a rich flavour. A favourite fig for jam & preserving. **Self-fertile**

Brunoro – A highly ornamental tree that produces delicious fruit twice throughout the year in January & April. The fruit is purple-black with a succulent red flesh. **Self-fertile**

French Sugar – This tree produces medium sized fruit with dark green skin & sweet, pale pink flesh. Heavy cropper. Late season variety. **Self-fertile**

Mrs. Williams – This fig is a very attractive tree that has the bonus of two crops of large fruit per year in January & April. The fruit is dark brown with red flesh & delicious. **Self-fertile**

Sweet Black - The fig tree is highly ornamental as well as providing us with a delicious edible fruit. Broad lobed glossy green foliage and sweet fruit that ripens around March. Needs a sheltered sunny spot. **Self-fertile**

GRAPES

Feed every 4 months with either Citrus food or Acid food if planted in the ground.

Black Buffalo - A high quality Table Grape with reddish-black fruit with an attractive bloom. The flesh is green, tender & juicy with a hint of spice. Regular generous cropper that shows good disease resistance. The fruit ripens around Feb-March.

Kyoho – A Grape that is huge in size and very, very sweet. Black-purple in colour, ripens in early Autumn.

Moore's Diamond – The skin & flesh are greenish white & have a tangy flavour. The grapes ripen around March. Shows good disease resistance.

Robinson – A nice table grape with deep purple to black bunches of grapes which are produced regularly & reliably. Ripen around March-April. **Confirmed 10 Harrison's**

Schuyler - An excellent table Grape with sweet and juicy blue-black bunches that ripen around March. The grapes are often described as having a slight currant flavour. Shows good disease resistance. Plant in a sunny well drained spot and prune in winter after leaf fall.

HAZELNUTS

From \$49.95

Barcelona – A well flavoured nut. Hazelnuts are highly valued for their delicious taste plus the fact they are high in protein & unsaturated fat. "Barcelona" is a vigorous grower that produces large nuts in great quantities. Requires a pollinator. **Pollinate with Merville de Bolwillier**

Merville de Bolwillier – Not only is this a great looking deciduous tree that is extremely hardy it will also provide you with delicious, nutritious Hazelnuts in January/February. The large round nuts are packed with Vitamin E & antioxidants. Produces large nuts. Used mainly as a pollinator!

Tonda Romano – Produces good crops of small-medium sized nuts with excellent flavour.

Pollinators: Barcelona, Merville de Bolwillier

Whiteheart – New Zealand's most popular hazelnut grown mainly for processing. Good crops of small round nuts. **Pollinators include Alexandra, Merville de Bolwillier.**

NECTARINES

This selection of Nectarines are on Peach rootstock should grow to 3-4 metres.

(All Nectarines are self-fertile) \$59.95 each

Fantasia - A popular, large, yellow freestone that's firm when ripe, but oh, so juicy. The taste is sweet, but tangy, & very rich. Nectarines are large and brightly coloured. Good for fresh eating, canning and pies. Ripens in late August. **Self-fertile**

Goldmine – An enduring favourite, this variety has fruit that ripen in mid-February. The medium sized fruit have mainly red over green skin. The flesh is white, freestone, juicy & aromatic. Good dessert & fresh eating variety. Vigorous & highly productive tree. **Self-fertile**

Newboy - Large, red skinned fruit with white juicy flesh that has an exquisite flavour. Produces well with crops ripening Jan-Feb. Freestone. Plant in a sunny well drained spot. **Self-fertile**

Redgold - Is one of the most widely planted nectarines in the country. It produces a large, yellow, freestone fruit that has a beautiful red blushed skin that covers a firm, juicy flesh. During the spring the tree dazzles with stunning pink flowers. **Self-fertile**

DWARF NECTARINE TREES (ON A 50cm STANDARD)

Plant in a sunny well-drained spot or perhaps a container. \$59.95 each

Flavourzee –Mid-season yellow fleshed fruit of good size & eating quality. This tree Forms a compact habit. Self-fertile. – on a 50cm Standard

Garden Delight – You will be delighted with this delicious dwarf Nectarine that is small in size but not on taste. Large, yellow, juicy freestone fruit ripen about March/April. Pretty pink blossom in spring.

Nectar Babe – Nectar Babe is a great choice for smaller gardens. The fruit is an attractive bright red with flavourful, sweet juicy freestone flesh. **Needs Flavourzee for Pollination.**

OLIVES - From \$19.95 each

Different varieties & grades are available throughout the season.

Ascolano – This Olive is popular for the large fruits that have a delicate mild taste. The Olives stay green rather than the usual black when ripe. The attractive grey/green foliage is slightly twisted.

Pollinators – Leccino, Frantoio

El Greco - It has a nice compact form making a good choice for topiary work. Attractive grey green foliage & small white flowers followed by heavy crops of small fruit that have good oil content.

Frantoio - Frantoio produces quite small Olives that are very high in oil content. Highly ornamental as well as productive. Plant in a sunny well drained spot. **Self-fertile**

Leccino - A popular Olive that produces a strong spicy flavoured oil. Equally desirable as a highly ornamental evergreen tree with attractive grey-green foliage.

Manzanillo – This Olive has large fruit that ripen in early autumn and are perfect for pickling. Quickly forms a nice specimen tree with attractive grey-green foliage. Happiest in the sun with protection from harsh wind. **Self-fertile**

Picual – Early producing olive. High yields, high oil content & ripens mid to late season. Performs well from cold to subtropical climate. **Self-fertile**

PEACHES

This selection of Peaches are on peach rootstock & should grow to approximately 3-4 metres \$59.95 each

- Blackboy** - A stunning peach with a dark wine coloured outer and inner. The rich, juicy, textured flesh is absolutely delicious. A firm favourite. Ideal for bottling. **Self-fertile.**
- Glo Haven** - This tree has large sized fruit with skin that is blushed red over yellow & described as "nearly fuzz-less". The freestone flesh is yellow, nice & sweet with a mild flavour. Plant in a well-drained sunny spot.
- Golden Queen** - NZ's favourite peach. The Golden Queen peach is firm, tasty with golden yellow flesh. Great for bottling or eating straight from the tree. Crops well, ripens in late February/March. Cling-stone.
- Hiawatha** - An attractive peach tree with deep-purple leaves in the Spring that fade to purple-green in the Summer. It produces pink blossoms & purple-skinned fruit with orange flesh & a good flavour. The pink blossoms appear From Late-Winter to Late Spring. An excellent choice for fresh eating.
