<b>Banksia Rosea Alba</b>	A vigorous, largely thornless, historic climbing rose known for its early spring display of dainty, double, pure white, fragrant flowers in clusters, growing quickly to cover walls or arches, thriving in warm spots, It's popular for pergolas, fences, & as a specimen, producing masses of blooms on semi-evergreen foliage, making it a beautiful, low-maintenance climber.	<b>\$29.95</b>	<b>Y</b>

<b>Clematis Guernsey Cream</b>	A stunning large-flowered variety that produce an abundance of cream white flowers with a chartreuse central stripe. Flowers in late Spring to early Summer then again in late Summer to early Autumn. They are a vigorous grower, hardy & deciduous thriving in either full sun or partial shade where soils are suitably moist, fertile and free-draining.	<b>\$42.25</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Clematis paniculata</b>	NZ Native. Suitable for trellises, walls or rambling joyfully through trees. Festoons of large, starry, pure white blooms with golden anthers appear in spring, followed by silken seed heads. Keep roots cool with a nice layer of mulch. Evergreen.	<b>\$43.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Clematis Snowdrift</b>	A vigorous, evergreen climber with dark green foliage, new growth has a bronze tinge. Fragrant, pure white flowers begin to appear in Spring and through Summer. Shelter from strong winds & harsh frosts. Can be trimmed back after flowering has finished.		<b>N</b>
<b>Clematis Snowflake</b>	This beautiful deciduous climber is deservedly popular. As the new leaves just start to emerge in spring the tight white buds open to large snowy white blooms that smother the whole vine for a breath-taking display. <b>Hardenbergia Happy Wanderer</b>	A vigorous climber or trailing plant that will provide dense cover to just about anything - including walls, steep banks, pergolas and fences. It will tolerate light frosts. An excellent cultivar for use as a climber or groundcover. It is flowering in winter and early spring. Then it is covered in a solid mass of deep mauve-purple pea flowers.		<b>N</b>

<b>Lonicera Dropmore</b>	(Climbing Honeysuckle) - Is a vigorous, semi-evergreen climbing vine popular in New Zealand for its stunning, fragrant, scarlet-orange trumpet flowers from Summer to Autumn. Evergreen. <b>(4m)</b>	<b>\$32.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Lonicera Graham Thomas</b>	Fabulously fragrant, large, tubular, white flowers, ageing to yellow amidst oval, mid-green leaves. Nothing beats their sweet honeyed fragrance on a warm summer breeze. <b>Pandorea pandorana (Wonga Vine)</b>	This rapid & strong growing climber has handsome glossy green foliage made up of divided leaflets. Panicles of tubular bell-shaped flowers in rich cream with spotted throats appear in spring and summer & emit a lovely fragrance. Plant in a sheltered, sunny position. <b>Parthenocissus tri Vetchii (Boston Ivy)</b>	A rapid growing self-clinging climber that holds firmly with small suction cups. Outstanding Autumn colours.		<b>N</b>

<b>Tracleospermum asiaticum</b>	Hardy evergreen vine covered in fragrant cream yellow flowers through Summer. Climbs with support or can be used as groundcover. Excellent in pots. Sun to part sun in any reasonable soil.		
<b>Trachelospermum jasminoides</b>	(Star Jasmine) Evergreen vine used as a climber with support or hedge. Rich green foliage enhanced by star shaped white flowers that are richly scented.	<b>From \$24.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Vitis amurensis Alicante Bouchet</b>	A hardy, ornamental grape with purple-green foliage during Summer that turns to various shades of orange, scarlet and yellow in Autumn. Best grown in a sunny position where soils are free-draining and use some kind of structure to provide support as it grows. Prune as required.		<b>Y</b>
<b>Wisteria Amethyst</b>	A NZ selection of the popular graceful Chinese Wisteria. 30cm long racemes of dark mauve blossom appear before the foliage in early spring. The heady fragrance will delight as it wafts through the garden.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Wisteria Blue Sapphire</b>	One of the best selected forms that produces a pendulous profusion of highly fragrant racemes of deep lavender blue in early spring prior to leaf. Prolific grower.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Wisteria Geisha</b>	This Japanese Wisteria is a vigorous climber that will delight you with 35cm long racemes of dainty pale blue-mauve in spring. The blooms emerge at the same time as the spring foliage and carry a soft perfume. Easy to grow in a sunny spot but will need a good support structure.		<b>N</b>
<b>Wisteria Lavender Lace</b>	A form of Japanese Wisteria that has beautiful mauve/purple flowers that appear with the new leaves in spring. Plant where you can walk under the dripping fragrant racemes. Requires a good support structure.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Wisteria Lipstick</b>	Long, fragrant racemes of mauve-pink to soft pink flowers that emerge in spring with new leaves, fading to white, creating a beautiful contrast with dark green foliage turning yellow in autumn; it's a vigorous, deciduous climber great for pergolas, needing sun and well-drained soil.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
