<b>Banksia “The Pearl”</b>	A sweet little rose that has dark green foliage & thorn-less stems. During spring and summer clusters of small, double, white blooms appear. Nice soft fragrance. Good disease resistance.	<b>\$36.75</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Banksia Lutea</b>	Is a rambling rose that blooms well before most other roses, bearing hanging sprays of small, double, primrose-yellow flowers. Thornless & evergreen. Lightly scented. <b>Grows to 12m</b>	<b>\$36.75</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Deciduous Clematis availability ranges from time to time – please inquire.</b>			
<b>Clematis paniculata</b>	<b>NZ Native.</b> Suitable for trellises, walls or rambling joyfully through trees. Festoons of large, starry, pure white blooms with golden anthers appear in spring, followed by silken seed heads. Keep roots cool with a nice layer of mulch. Evergreen.	<b>\$35.20</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Clematis Snowdrift</b>	A vigorous, evergreen climber with dark green foliage, new growth has a bronze tinge. Fragrant, pure white flowers begin to appear in Spring and through Summer. Plant in a warm, sunny position where soils are moist and free-draining. Shelter from strong winds & harsh frosts. Can be trimmed back after flowering has finished.	<b>\$41.80</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Hardenbergia “Happy Wanderer”</b>	This will bring some welcome colour to your garden in winter and spring as long as you give it a warm sheltered position in the garden. Dark green leathery foliage & racemes of purple pea like flowers. Evergreen	<b>\$28.35</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Jasminum azoricum</b>	Rarely without orange scented waxy white flowers & once established will withstand winter cold. Graceful twining glossy green leaves to 3m		<b>N</b>
<b>Jasminum polyanthum</b>	Strong evergreen climber with masses of white flowers after pink buds. Highly fragrant. Popular as a quick growing cover for fences & trellis	<b>\$31.80</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Lapageria Rosea</b>	A beautiful climbing plant from Chile producing pendulous bells of waxy, soft crimson flowers from summer to autumn. Foliage is a glossy, leathery dark-green. Evergreen. A very unique and precious climber.	<b>\$41.80</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Pandorea jas. Deep Pink</b>	Is a fast-growing evergreen climber with glossy dark green leaves & clusters of deep pink trumpet flowers during Spring & Summer. Ideal for covering fences, walls & arches	<b>\$33.50</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Pandorea “Lady Di”</b>	An attractive climber with glossy deep green leaves. Pure white flowers with yellow throats from late spring to autumn. Great for covering fences, archways, trellis or pergolas.		<b>N</b>
<b>Pandorea pandorana (Wonga Vine)</b>	This rapid & strong growing climber has handsome glossy green foliage made up of divided leaflets. Panicles of tubular bell-shaped flowers in rich cream with spotted throats appear in spring and summer & emit a lovely fragrance. Plant in a sheltered, sunny position. <b>Parthenocissus quinquefolia</b>	This vigorous creeper will quickly cover any wall, trellis or bank that you care to drape it over, Handsome lobed leaves in rich green that turn to tones of brilliant orange and scarlet red in autumn. Likes the sun and humus rich soil.	<b>\$28.50</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Solanum Potato Vine</b>	It is a fast-growing shrubby vine. It blooms over a long period, from late spring to autumn. Flowers are white with yellow stamens. Very fast grower & will tolerate frost once established although protect when young.		<b>N</b>
<b>Trachelospermum jasminoides</b>	Evergreen vine used as a climber with support or hedge. Rich green foliage enhanced by star shaped white flowers that are richly scented.	<b>From \$23.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Vitis amurensis Alicante Bouchet</b>	A hardy ornamental grape with purple-green foliage during Summer that turns to various shades of orange, scarlet & yellow in Autumn.	<b>From \$21.95</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Wisteria Amethyst</b>	A NZ selection of the popular graceful Chinese Wisteria. 30cm long racemes of dark mauve blossom appear before the foliage in early spring. The heady fragrance will delight as it wafts through the garden.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	
<b>Wisteria Blue Sapphire</b>	One of the best selected forms that produces a pendulous profusion of highly fragrant racemes of deep lavender blue in early spring prior to leaf. Prolific grower.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	
<b>Wisteria Cascade</b>	Cascade is a form of Japanese Wisteria that has beautiful mauve/pink flowers that appear with the new leaves in spring. Plant where you can walk under the dripping fragrant racemes. Deciduous	<b>From \$44.95</b>	

<b>Wisteria Geisha</b>	This Japanese Wisteria is a vigorous climber that will delight you with 35cm long racemes of dainty pale blue-mauve in spring. The blooms emerge at the same time as the spring foliage and carry a soft perfume. Easy to grow in a sunny spot but will need a good support structure.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	
<b>Wisteria Lavender Lace</b>	A form of Japanese Wisteria that has beautiful mauve/purple flowers that appear with the new leaves in spring. Plant where you can walk under the dripping fragrant racemes. Requires a good support structure.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	
<b>Wisteria Misty Mauve</b>	Misty mauve is a form of Wisteria that has beautiful mauve/Violet flowers that appear with the new leaves in spring. Plant where you can walk under the dripping fragrant racemes.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	
<b>Wisteria Shiro Kaptan</b>	This vigorous plant, the earliest white-flowered cultivar to flower, looks good grown on a red brick wall. Its short racemes hold 20-35 white flowers, each with a faint, yellow blotch.	<b>From \$44.95</b>	
<b>Wisteria Snow Showers</b>	Simply stunning in full flower with long drooping racemes up to 50cm long of fragrant white blooms. The flowers appear along with fresh lime green spring foliage. Adds romance and drama to any garden. Likes the sun and of course support.	<b>From \$44.95</b>
