<b>LEMON, YELLOW &amp; APRICOT BLOOMS</b>		
<b>Bonnie Doone</b>	A lovely dwarf form. Golden yellow flowers with a wavy edge. Soft trusses and good glossy foliage. Medium bushy habit. <b>(1.2m x 1.2m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Butterhorn</b>	Fine bright yellow trumpet shaped flowers. Strong yellow green buds open bright yellow, darker in throat. An upright bushy to open shrub. Flowers in November.	<b>Y</b>
<b>Double Eagle</b>	The large flowers are pink in bud opening to a warm yellow with a fuchsia blotch. Very beautiful. Flowering in October <b>1.5m</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Horizon Monarch</b>	Has apricot buds open to large creamy flowers, beautiful! Flowers from October <b>(1.5mx1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Johnstoneum</b>	A medium height shrub that flowers early to mid-season with large, lightly fragrant soft cream buds that open in shades of buff to white with yellow throats in Spring. <b>(1.2m x 1.2m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Lemon Lodge</b>	A beautiful plant, with soft primrose yellow flowers smothering the bush. Giving a translucent glow in partial shade this rhododendron will light up any corner. Free flowering, bushy habit. <b>(1.4mx1.2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Lemon Mist</b>	This Dwarf Rhododendron has yellow greenish coloured flowers that appear in spring & a compact habit. Happiest in acid soil in dappled shade. <b>(1.5mx1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Micheals Pride</b>	Rhododendron Micheals Pride buds are a warm yellow, but open creamy white fading to pure white. Flowers are thick & waxy, rather like a lily in appearance. Interesting foliage with a textured look. Best pruned to keep a good shape Flowering in October <b>(1.5mx1.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Mrs Betty Robertson</b>	Is a pale yellow with pink flush, aging to cream, with a red freckling on the dorsal lobes. Flowers in October <b>(1.5mx1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Yellow Moon</b>	An outstanding Rhodo. with gorgeous blooms that appear mid spring. Coral pink buds open to frilly, waxy blooms made up of a mass of lemon, bell-shaped flowers. Glossy green foliage and a nice compact habit.	<b>N</b>
<b>PINK/PURPLE BLOOMS</b>		
<b>Alice</b>	Gorgeous trusses of deep pink flowers which gradually fade to pale rose and almost to white when in a sunny site. This is a tall growing shrub which is sun tolerant. <b>(1.8m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Annah Kruschke</b>	A lovely Rhododendron with deep green foliage & a neat & tidy habit. The compact trusses of bloom appear in spring & are in tones of pale lavender and purple with a hint of red at the throat. <b>(2.5m x 1.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Anna Rose Whitney</b>	Very large, rounded trusses of brilliant bright pink flowers decorate this Rhododendron in spring. Vigorous bushy growth habit with attractive foliage. <b>(1.5mx1.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Apple Brandy</b>	Excellent Compact plant with stunning foliage. Beautiful showy trusses of cream flowers with an attractive pink edge stand out against the leathery green foliage in spring. <b>(1mx1m)</b>	<b>Y</b>

**PINK/PURPLE BLOOMS CONTINUED....**

<b>Arnold Piper</b>	Rhododendron Arnold Piper have large dark pink funnel shaped flowers with a lighter pink centre, As the flower fades to a light rose with age, deep red spots appear in the white centre. Flowers in October. <b>1.5m.</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Barmstedt</b>	Rhodo. Barmstedt a very floriferous plant with rose pink flowers lighter pink towards the centre with a darker spotted eye. New growth is silver changing to dark green on a compact plant. Flowers in October. <b>1.2m</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Blue Diamond</b>	Wonderfully showy Rhododendron, low growing evergreen shrub that produces a massive display of deep violet-blue flowers in spring. Plant in sun/part shade in lime-free soil. <b>(1.2m x 1.2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Broxton</b>	Huge satin purple/pink flowers with an unusual show blotch of deep purple on the upper petal. <b>(2m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Bruce Brechtill</b>	Beautiful small compact growing Rhodo. Flowers are profuse when out & make a spectacular display of subtle pink & cream, almost transparent in appearance. <b>(2mx1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Bumblebee</b>	You'll get a real buzz when you see 'Bumble Bee' blooming its head off in your garden in spring. Large rounded trusses made up of 25 flowers that are vivid purple with a deep maroon blotch. Handsome dark glossy green foliage.	<b>N</b>
<b>Centennial Day</b>	Delightful mauve buds open into frilly pink flowers. Rhododendron's prefer dappled shade, but can be grown in full sun if protected from afternoon sun or kept well watered. Prune after flowering to maintain shape and to promote new growth. <b>(1.5m x 1m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Charisma</b>	Pretty delicate rose coloured buds open to rose pink flowers. Rhododendron's prefer dappled shade, but can be grown in full sun if protected from afternoon sun or kept well watered. Prune after flowering to maintain shape and to promote new growth. <b>(1.8m x 1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Christmas Cheer</b>	Neat frilly trusses of pink buds opening blush pink, fading to a very pale pink, blooms early. A bushy compact habit. <b>(2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Cupcake</b>	Blooms in early to mid-May with abundantly produced apricot - salmon pink flowers that age to a mix of refreshingly tropical hues. Flowers are funnel campanulate opening to a deep pink with sparse red spotting. <b>(60cm)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Denali</b>	Beautiful, large trusses of rich rose-pink flowers with paler centres and waved petal edges. Flowers in October. Grows approximately <b>1.8m.</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Hydon Hunter</b>	This "Yak" hybrid will be small and compact with the flowers which are large & showy. The flowers appear in spring & are toned reddish-purple with a margin of pink. <b>(1mx1m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Kalinka</b>	A compact bushed with glossy leaves with a brown colouring on the underside. Ruffled, pink flowers open from red buds in Spring. <b>(1m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Lady Adam Gordon</b>	Rhododendron Lady Adam Gordon has rounded trusses of bright pink flowers that hold their colour well. This is a Yakushmanum hybrid with tight, compact growth. Prefers semi-shade and an acid soil. <b>1.2m</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Lem's Monarch</b>	Rhododendron Lem's Monarch is a hardy, floriferous and has a good habit. Makes a fantastic long-lasting display in flower. Strong pink buds open to white flowers edged with soft pink. Flowering in November <b>(1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Melrose Flash</b>	Rhododendron Melrose Flash is a beautiful bi coloured rhodo of pink, white and yellow Stunning foliage that is wider than it is tall. Flowers in November. <b>1.5m</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Mount Clearview</b>	Features large & showy trusses of two-tone pink flowers with a dark blotch in late Spring. <b>(1.5m x 1.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>

<b>Mt Lorna Prieta</b>	Rhodo. Mount Loma Prieta has large trusses of soft apricot pink flowers. Flowers in October. <b>2m</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Noyo Brave</b>	The flowers are a lively bright pink, that soften with age. A small red blotch appears on the inside of the flower. Lovely dark green glossy leaves.	<b>Y</b>
<b>Pink Perfection</b>	Rosy pink blooms-tinged mauve.	<b>Y</b>
<b>Pink Trumpets</b>	A nicely foliated plant with large, pale shell-pink, trumpet-shaped flowers that have the most wonderful fragrance. <b>(1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Red Dawn</b>	A wonderful yak. hybrid from Germany. A compact growing plant with a rounded shape. Red buds open to strong pink flowers that fade to a pale pink throat. <b>1mtr.</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Ruby Bowman</b>	Ruby Bowman has long-lasting rose-pink flowers with a darker eye. Long flat leaves enhance the overall appearance of this vigorous and handsome plant. Plant habit is wide and bushy. <b>(1.5m x 1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Sneezy</b>	Rhododendron Sneezy has dark pink buds opening to a soft pink flower with a white eye deep inside the flower. Wine red spotting on the lobe. Flowering in November. <b>1.5m</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Solidarity</b>	Deep pink flowers with a purplish red edge. Flowers mid to late season. Dense, rounded habit. Plant in part shade in moist, well-drained soil. Evergreen. 1m.	<b>Y</b>
<b>Sweet Sixteen</b>	Compact evergreen shrub with broad, moderately branched habit and deep-green foliage. In August, large, ball-shaped trusses of purple-pink blooms with wavy lobes emerge to provide a stunning show. <b>1.5m</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Vibrant Violet</b>	A compact Rhododendron with abundant small, frilly violet flowers set against lush deep green evergreen foliage. Ideal for garden beds, borders and sheltered spots. Flowers in early October. <b>(1.5m x 1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Yaku Prince</b>	Deep pink buds open up to showy, strong pink blooms. As they age, they develop a beautiful contrast of faded petals with darker pink markings. New foliage emerges silvery green, and matures to a crisp green with orange-yellow undersides. <b>(50cm x 1m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>RED BLOOMS</b>		
<b>Bibiani</b>	Drop dead gorgeous flowers of deep waxy red decorate the glossy deep green foliage from late winter-early spring. Vigorous and easy to grow in dappled light. <b>(3mx2.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Black Magic</b>	Decadent deep black red blooms appear in late spring. Dense compact habit with dark green foliage. <b>(1.6m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Grace Seabrook</b>	Rhodo. Lady Adam Gordon has rounded trusses of bright pink flowers that hold their colour well. This is a Yaku. hybrid with tight, compact growth. Prefers semi-shade and an acid soil. Mulch to keep the roots cool. <b>1.2m</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Jean Marie De Montague</b>	This dense evergreen shrub has dark green foliage with deep crimson-scarlet flowers. Requires part shade and moist but well-drained soil. <b>(1.5m x 1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Kaponga</b>	Bright glowing red blooms with neat rounded truss. Excellent blooming in the early to mid-season. A large vigorous tree like habit. <b>(2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Manderley</b>	Lovely cardinal-red bell-shaped flowers in rounded trusses. Reddish new growth and a compact mounding habit. <b>(1.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>President Roosevelt</b>	A Rhodo. with variegated foliage, dark green with a central splash of yellow. Produces a mass of trumpet-shaped, pinkish-red flowers that fade to white in the centres which begin to emerge from early Spring. <b>(1.2m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Rubicon</b>	A stunning red Rhododendron with large trusses of up to 18 flowers in cardinal red and a spotted black throat. <b>(2mx1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>

<b>Tally Ho</b>	Gorgeous flowers of bright orange-scarlet with darker spots deep in the throat bloom in early summer, well after most other species and hybrids have finished flowering. A light brown, felted indumentum covers the new growth. Best in light shade to protect the summer blossoms. Acid soil. Evergreen. <b>1.8m</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Vulcans Flame</b>	Handsome dark green foliage, a broad rounded habit & ravishing red blooms in spring. The flowers present themselves in large domed trusses. <b>(2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>WHITE BLOOMS</b>		
<b>Cherry Cheesecake</b>	Has pure white blooms with dark pink edging & a deep burgundy blotch funnel-shaped blooms. Good compact form and shape. <b>(1.2mx1.2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Countess of Haddington</b>	An easy care free flowering evergreen shrub with fragrant large white flowers, pale pink outside which flower in Spring. <b>(2mx1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Elsie Frye</b>	Large white flowers with chrome-yellow throat exterior flushed rose. Very Fragrant! <b>(1.5mx2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Helene Schiffner</b>	In spring mauve buds open to pure white flowers with a dusting of green in the throat. Very beautiful. The red stems complete the picture. <b>(2mx1.5m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Floral Fete</b>	Lovely, long lily-white flowers with yellow centres. Tall & upright plant. <b>(1.5m x1.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Grumpy</b>	Has pale pink buds that open to cream flowers with soft pale pink at edges. Fades to cream colour. One of the seven dwarf series. Flowers in October. <b>(1m x 1m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>John Bull</b>	Worth planting in the garden for the fragrance alone but you will also be delighted by the pink buds that open out into pretty palest pink-cream blooms in spring. Nice foliage too. <b>(1mx1m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Kings Cream</b>	Vigorously growing Rhododendron, bushy form of large, rounded leaves. Flowers in large, conical trusses of rich cream. Mid-season blooming. Happiest with dappled light. <b>(1.5m x 1.5m)</b>	
<b>Mi Amor</b>	One of our most popular fragrant rhodos. Strong perfume. Large white flowers with flushed yellow throat. Tends to have a slightly open habit. <b>(1.5m x 1.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Mt Everest</b>	A vigorous and reliable Rhododendron with large trusses of snowy white flowers with a hint of brown speckling in the throat. Flowers in spring. <b>(2.5m x 2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Princess Alice</b>	A compact plant that has fragrant elegant white blooms that open from pale pink buds. <b>(2mx2m)</b>	<b>Y</b>
<b>Sappho</b>	Striking blooms of white, blotched with purple-black appear in nice round trusses. <b>(2mx1.5m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Tiana</b>	A hardy evergreen shrub which has large, frilly pure white blooms with rich maroon markings that begin to emerge in Spring. <b>(1.2m x 1.2m)</b>	<b>N</b>
<b>Unique</b>	Fantastic all-round performer for flower & foliage. Beautiful buttery cream flowers smother the plant with a pinkish bud to begin with. Flowers in October. <b>(1.2mx1.2m)</b>	<b>N</b>
